

A WELL MADE DEBUT

This movie has surfaced from time to time for me with varying intervals. That it was in fact a debut refuses this movie with in-depth elements as it is not believed at the beginning of the film. George Clooney and Tilda Swinton makes exceptionally good roles, something that Swinton was later praised for. Another part that surprised me was how well compressed scenes it had. With their clarity enshrined, the characters to the script and created a well-founded credibility which was followed to the end. Right from the start, violates the normal standards that you usually see in a video produced by a Hollywood company. She has one of one win each nomination when it comes to the Oscar statuette. She also has a distinct character and a resistance that is hard to measure. Tom Wilkinson, the man who tried to destroy Bruce Wayne in Nolan's Batman trilogy, actually shows a completely different side of her talent. Although Wilkinson was about 60 when the film was shot, so most of the roles he has played in, has been mainly noted recently. He makes a solid interpretation. The irony is that Denzel Washington denied a role in the film simply because he did not want to work with a first-time Director. And Clooney made similar statement, however, so I think that Clooney had performed better than Denzel.

Tony Gilroy has created a movie that is unfortunately a little too underrated and not appreciated to the level it actually deserves. It has valuable intrigue and topped voltage not going to escape. I would highly recommend this film, mainly because the script and cinematograph but also how the characters are portrayed by these talented actors.
